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Illegal Burn	Without a permit or burning with a permit (only 1 warning then fine) during burn season and failing to call Dispatch. Burning with a permit, but during non burn times or not in burn season or during a fire ban or restrictions or other violations of permit	\$200 for 2nd offense for burning without a permit and double everytime after that. After 1st warning for residence with a burn permit then \$200 for 2nd offense and double for everytime after.
	If a wildland or structure fire is caused by an illegal burn	\$500 per apparatus per hour, \$100 per firefighter and \$.10 per gal of water used.

Interference with a Firefighter, Fire Marshal, Fire Inspector, Fire Investigator, EMS or Communications Personnel		\$500
Fire Code Violation without compliance	Enforcement of this will be through the Fire Chief. I will present our case to the Chief and the Chief will decide to fine or not. If to fine, a letter will be written with the violation, corrective action date and if not corrected by this date, then you will be fined,a certain amount per date from a date set by the Fire Chief.	\$50 per day per violation
Fire Alarm False Alarm and Repeated False Alarm Fee	False alarm has to be caused by a maintenance or occupant(s) action to cause alarm/suppression activation	\$200 after 3 alarms in a 3 month period
Monitoring and/or Fire Alarm companies who fail to call us before working on a fire alarm or suppression system and resulted in a fire response.	We have responded numerous times to commerical buildings due to fire alarm companies testing the buildings fire alarm/suppression system and fail to call us. We either have the monitoring company call, a person in the building or someone just driving by.	\$250
Fire Alarm/Suppression system company who put a fire protection system system out of service and fails to call us	Per International Fire Code (IFC 2012), section 901.7 requires fire departments to be notified when a fire protection system is put out of service.	\$250
