#### **Position Summary:**

The position of Fuels Module Crewmember will be a team oriented, hardworking individual for the Evergreen Fire Protection District. The Module typically works a 40-hour week, though may often require considerable additional work hours for incident response, meeting attendance, training, and performance of other duties.

#### **Essential Functions:**

The job duties and responsibilities listed in this job announcement are for illustrative purposes only. The duties of this position may change based on the needs of the district and additional direction from the Fuels Module Supervisor. Specific duties and responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Participating in the chipping program, assist with home assessments, work on full scale mitigation projects throughout the district, and slash pile construction/burning
- Participating in the physical training (PT) program each day throughout the season with the Module
- Responding to wildland fire calls and participating in wildland fire training and best mitigation practices
- Working with chainsaws, chippers, wildfire engines, pumps, and hand tools
- Participating in initial attack, extended attack, and mop up operations
- Perform other job-related duties as assigned by the Fuels Module Supervisor

#### **Minimum Education and Experience:**

- 18 years old or older
- High School Diploma or GED
- Driver's License with no major violations
- Current or ability to obtain CPR Certification
- ICS 100, 200, 700, 800 (or within 30 days of employment)
- Firefighter Type 2 (FFT2) S-130/S-190, L-180 (or will obtain upon employment)

#### **Job Specifications:**

##### **Ability to have knowledge of:**

The principles, practices, methods, and equipment employed in modern wildland firefighting and mitigation practices

##### **Must have the ability to:**

- Effectively communicate
- Utilize excellent organizational skills and have the ability to work well under pressure of deadlines and changing priorities
- Pass a two-part physical exam by our provider that includes ability to perform the following:
  - Pushups (30 in 60 seconds)
  - Pull-ups (4 minimum)
  - Sit-ups (30 in 60 seconds)
  - 1.5 mile run (11:30)
- Pass a background check
- Meet expectations of the Fuels Module Supervisor for daily work assignments and physical training program.
- Maintains minimum training requirements and certifications as required

#### **Working Conditions:**

This position requires a high level of physical fitness and durability. It will include passing the arduous physical pack test and other physical activities associated with wildland firefighting.
