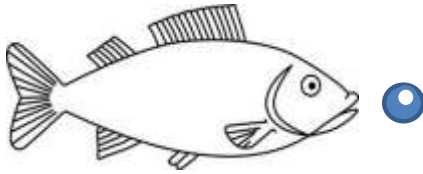


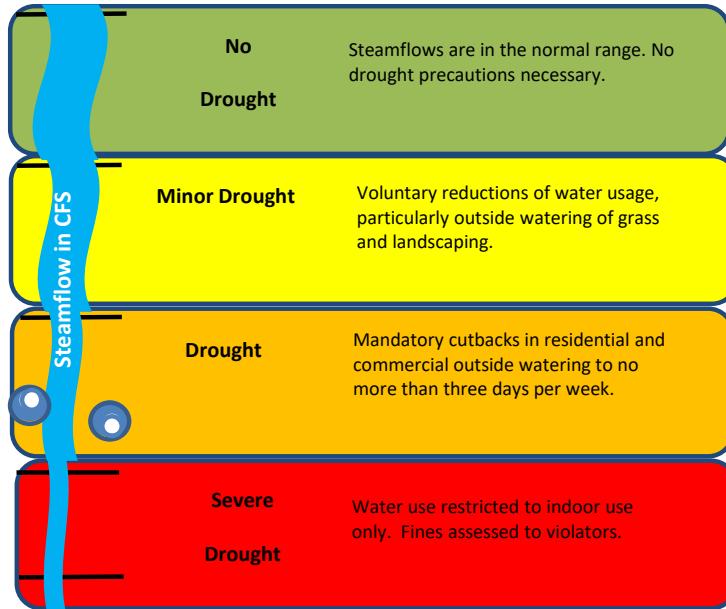
**EVERGREEN METRO DISTRICT, WATER CONSERVATION GRAPH
MANDATORY WATER CONSERVATION**

Level 2 Drought in effect as of July 13, 2020.

EMD will remain in Level 2 Drought for the remainder of the 2020 irrigation season. Despite the rain, the stream flow continues to remain low in Bear Creek.

Drought Response Level #2

Residential & Irrigation taps will be limited to water use of 14,000 gallons per billing cycle per equivalent tap, and all water used at and above that amount will be billed with a drought penalty rate of \$15.00 per 1000 gallons.

Penalties will be waived for first time offenders; however, 2nd offenses and on will be subject to \$50.00 per offense fines.

Watering zones should operate for irrigation no more than 30 minutes per zone per watering day.

All outside watering is required to occur before 10:00 AM and after 6:00 PM, unless maintenance of the irrigation system is involved.

All irrigation taps serving public parks and ball fields are asked to go to three-day per week irrigation watering, and reduce their water usage by 30% on a metered average.

Golf courses will be required to reduce their irrigation use by 30%.

Water rate penalties will go into effect for all tap users that ignore the cutback and watering time requirements.

All water haulers using the pay station will be limited to hauling for indoor use only. No hauling for irrigation purposes will be allowed. Violations of this will result in loss of hauling privileges.

Should stream flows in Bear Creek hold at or above 5 cfs at the Evergreen Lake gauge, this will be the extent of the action taken.

Should the stream flow 7 day average fall below 5cfs, the District will move into Drought Response Level 3 and further details will be provided.
